4. GENERAL ELIGIBILITY

This annual award is open to 'Physicians/Clinicians, Healthcare Researchers / Faculty Member' of any nationality, who is in good standing at the time of nomination, and in the age group of 27 – 75 years with good academic and service record. The nominee must have completed a recognized Post Graduate/Doctorate Degree or its equivalent.

4.1 Issues Affecting the Eligibility

Any healthcare practitioner profile can be submitted for VIHA 2026 provided that there are no adverse outcomes (all findings) by the CONCERN AUTHORITY due to

- a) Misconduct
- b) Deficient professional performance
- c) Criminal conviction
- d) Caution and formal warnings
- e) Disciplinary action by the employer.

4.2 Evaluation Criteria

Exceptional Practice – Selfless Dedication and High Standards of Commitment – Distinct Innovations and Initiatives in Patient Care and Wellbeing – Policy Making and Planning in Healthcare Establishments – Contributions to Safety and Quality – Novel and Effective Treatment Methods.

5. AWARD CATEGORIES AND CRITERIA

5.1 Award for Excellence (Code: AE)

This award is established in 2018 and has been conferred for a remarkable Physicians/Clinicians who demonstrated a track record of exceptional practice/research, selfless dedication and sustained high standards of commitment that are reflected by the distinct innovations and initiatives in the patient care and wellbeing.

Criteria:

- ✓ The nominee must be well-known and should have a track record of sharing expertise with other professionals as documented by presentations, authorship of articles/papers.
- ✓ The nominee must have made a contribution to leadership, policy making and planning in healthcare research and establishments.
- ✓ The nominee must be above 44 years of age and at least have 20 years of service as on 1st December 2025.

5.2 Professor of the Year (Code: PY)

This award is established in 2018 and has been conferred for a remarkable healthcare faculty member who demonstrated exceptional academic records and a commitment to high standards of professional life, contributions to the institution and initiation of new services for students, faculty and other members of the community.

Criteria:

- ✓ The nominee must have track record of sustained excellence in institution initiatives that have had a significant impact on healthcare education and research. Contributions through leadership in faculty governance or administrative work, development of a new program, integration of innovative approaches to learning and publications (articles and books).
- ✓ The award is open to a faculty member working in an academic institution in the regular, research and teaching.
- ✓ The nominee must be above 50 years of age and at least have 25 years of service as on 1st December 2025.

- ✓ The nominee must have successfully introduced novel or effective treatment/research methods that are recognized by their peers.
- ✓ The nominee must be above 34 years of age and at least have 10 years of service as on 1st December 2025.

7. JUDGING

The VIHA 2026 judging is a peer review process. The panel (from diverse backgrounds, working individually) is instructed to score entries from 0 to 100, using the criteria (as mentioned in the section 3 and 5).

7.1. The panel aggregates scores and determine the category. The panel decision is final and binding.

7.2. For each category/specialty (Eg. Award for Excellence in Cardiology) the expert committee will select 2 nominees. However the apex committee reserve the rights to honour less or more than 2 nominees in any category who meet standards set by the expert committee.

7.3. The committee will use discretion if an individual is nominated for two concurrent awards and will move the nomination to appropriate category based on their judgment.

7.4. In case, if a nominee meets the criteria for an award, other than the one nominated for, the committee will be deciding to move the nomination to a suitable category.
